The Take-Away

The purpose of the Bishop's Annual Appeal is to raise enough funds to cover 100% of the annual budget for diocesan-sponsored programs, ministries, and the education of our seminarians. Right now, the 2019 budget for ministries and programs is \$11.5 million. Based on our recent history, we're expecting to raise \$7.5 million towards that number. The \$4.0 million "gap" is funded through parish assessments.

As you may know, the diocese has two main sources of revenue: the annual appeal and parish assessments. It's our goal to fully fund our annual budget through the appeal so that more money stays in our parishes, while at the same time advancing the good work of the diocese.

Currently, we have 196,000 registered households in the diocese. Roughly 13% or 25,000 households participate in the annual appeal with an average gift of \$25/month. The national average is 26% participation. If we were able to increase our participation rate to 20% and attract an additional 14,000 households or just 200 more households per parish at an average rate of \$25/month, we would be able to fully fund all of our diocesan programs and ministries.

39,000 households X \$25/month X 12 months = \$11.7 million

For 2019, we're not asking to raise your parish goals; we're asking that you help us get more households to participate, at any level, to further the work of the Gospel in our diocese.

Thank you for the work that you do in your parishes and in our greater Catholic community.

Checklist

AFTER THE HOMILY

	efully guide your parishioners through the invocess:
	Ask ushers to distribute the pledge cards or make sure the pledge cards and pencils are already in the pews.
	Invite parishioners that have given in the past to prayerfully consider increasing the amount of their gift. Remind parishioners that each Catholic family is being asked to make a pledge today.
	Request that parishioners wait so that all pledge cards can be filled out together. This ensures that each part of the pledge card is filled out properly and it also ensures that you are not rushing through the process. Fill out yours at the same time as this really helps promote unity and timing.
	Ask parishioners to write in the total amount of their pledge where it says "Total Pledge."
	Ask parishioners to write in the amount that is being enclosed on the pledge card where it says "Amount Enclosed" or '\$0' if nothing is being enclosed.

FTER T	HE HOMILY (CONTD)
	Ask parishioners to clearly print their name, address and other personal information on the pledge card.
	Parishioners who wish to pay by MasterCard or Visa should write in their 16-digit number, expiration date and sign the form. (MasterCard and Visa are the only credit cards accepted.) NOTE: Remember to provide the Bishop's Appeal office with your new credit card number and/or expiration date should it change during the year, so that there is no interruption of your pledge payments.
	Parishioners wishing to enclose a check (payable to the Bishop's Appeal) or cash should put the check or cash in the envelope with their pledge card.
	Ask parishioners to detach their pledge card and place in the envelope provided, and then ask the ushers to collect all completed pledge cards.
	Thank everyone for their patience and generosity!
