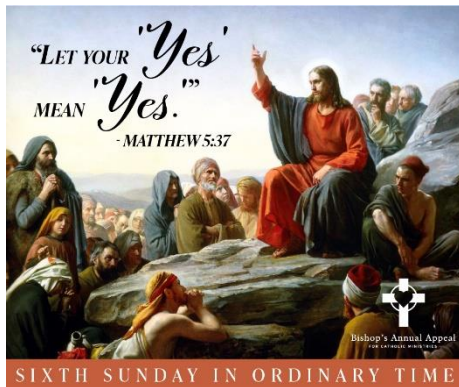


### **To Post the Week of February 6 (For the Weekend of February 11-12)**

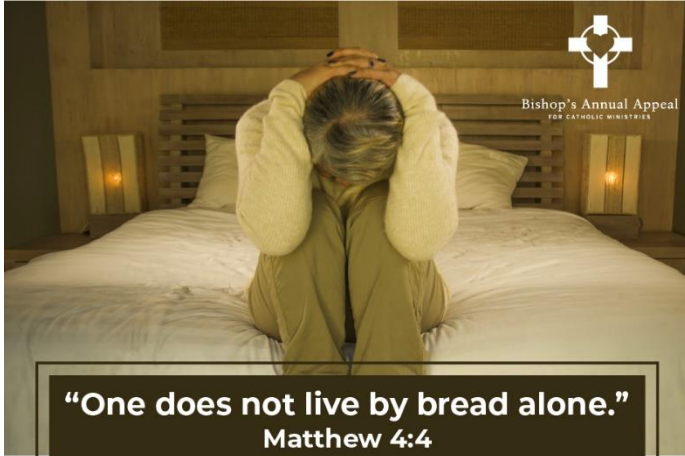
